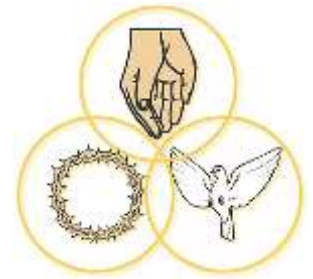

There But Not There...

REMINDER

'There But Not There' is a chance for you to buy and keep your own 'Tommy'. This will be the keepsake commemorating the centenary of the end of the 1914-1918 war and those who lost their lives. This 10" high Perspex 'Tommy' figure of a World War One soldier will be delivered to you in beautiful commemorative packaging.

Please note: The price of the Tommy is £32.99 including VAT & postage. Due to unprecedented support from the nation please allow six weeks for delivery. If you would like to have the name of the person you wish to remember on the base of the statue, you can download a voucher and take it to any Timpson store throughout the UK and they will do it for you for free.



We are asking that if you buy your own Tommy, that you lend it to us for the week leading up to Remembrance Sunday. We are hoping to have the name of each of the men on our WW1 war memorial engraved on a base.

If you are happy for your statue to carry one of their names then please choose a name and write your name next to theirs on the list in church.

However you may wish to have the name of one of your relatives, who served in the Great War, engraved on your Tommy. You can do that and it can still be used as part of our display and then be returned to you. If you are taking this option please would you add your name to the list in church so we know how many to expect.

You can collect your Tommy after the service on the 11th November.

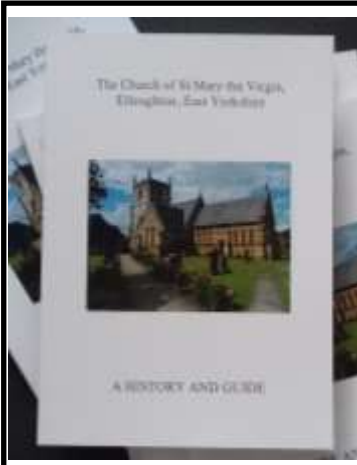
