## Financial Inclusion Project

Hull Foodbank have recently employed a highly trained worker to offer financial advice to clients through a grant from Trussell Trust.

In the first two months of the project, she has seen 43 people covering issues such as benefits, debt, housing, utilities and health.

£37.000 in financial gains was achieved for these clients. The advisor estimates that 35 people will no longer need to use a foodbank after accessing advice and support.

One client with multiple health conditions found that she was entitled to an extra £178 per week.

These figures are fantastic and a real encouragement in helping people out of financial dependency and poverty.



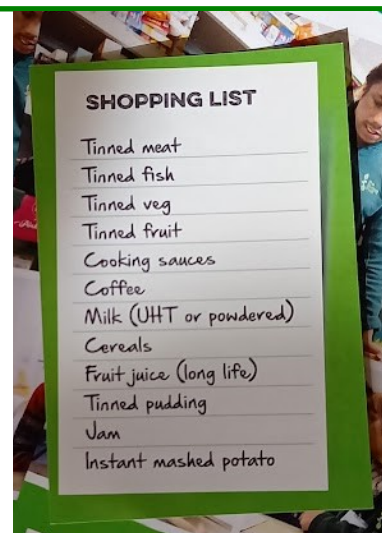
With the Vicarage soon to be vacant, we want to draw your attention to our church collection points.
