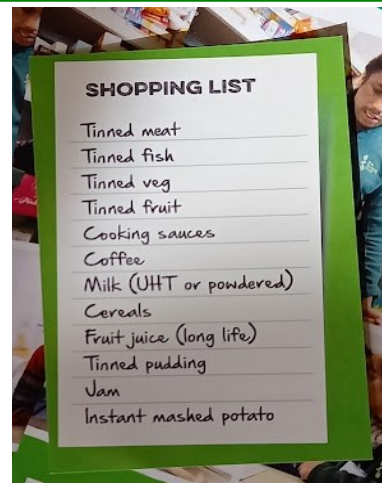

The Yeast of the Pharisees and Herod—Mark 8: 14-21

The disciples had forgotten to bring bread, except for one loaf they had with them in the boat. “Be careful,” Jesus warned them. “Watch out for the yeast of the Pharisees and that of Herod.”

They discussed this with one another and said, “It is because we have no bread.”

Aware of their discussion, Jesus asked them: “Why are you talking about having no bread? Do you still not see or understand? Are your hearts hardened? Do you have eyes but fail to see, and ears but fail to hear? And don’t you remember? When I broke the five loaves for the five thousand, how many basketfuls of pieces did you pick up?”

I wonder if you have ever left the house and forgotten something? Like the disciples I often get to the car only to realise I haven’t got something important with me. Maybe like them I get distracted by the day to day concerns of life, wondering if I have everything I need. It sometimes does really matter if we have what we need. For example, I recently watched an episode of the Apprentice, where a lovely young man forgot to add flour to his brownie mix, causing great hilarity for the rest of the team!

This applies to us in our churches too. For example we are in the process of reviewing our financial giving, which helps pay for our ‘daily bread’! We don’t yet seem to have everything we need through our own giving. As the cost of living goes up, our giving doesn’t always match this. But at the same time, we can let these concerns distract us from our focus on what Jesus is saying to us. A bit of a conundrum.

I pray therefore this Lent that we will gain wisdom in how God wants to bless us in a material way to take the small fishes and loaves we offer him and turn these into a banquet. I for one wouldn’t want to withhold from God anything he needs for his work in this world. My prayer for us this Easter is therefore that we have understanding of what God is asking of us, that our hearts are softened by him, our eyes opened, and ears unstopped. Maybe then we can experience his generosity and bountiful provision for our own lives, our church and the wider community.
