Signs of Spring

As we sense the beginning of warmer days ahead and spring approaching, it can be a great time of year for optimism. The buds on the trees appearing and new life emerging through snowdrops and crocuses again. We are exploring the area for the first time this spring and looking forward to finding where the bluebells grow and what plants lay dormant in the garden.

It can be difficult to take a step back from our busy lives to notice the changes around us. My grandfather was however a great diary keeper and kept the record of the temperature every day so he could compare notes! As a child I thought this was totally pointless! However today the impact of our lives on the environment is something we think about more often. If you take a daily walk, or are a keen gardener you might notice small changes at this time of year. Perhaps as a farmer you are trying to predict a bit further ahead. Perhaps a plant hasn't survived a wet winter, or the flowers have come earlier on a favourite shrub.

In just the same way, God takes careful note of us and our lives, and he has the ultimate attention to detail in how he plans and takes care of us too. Often knowing what we need much better than we can ever understand ourselves. I wonder then what springtime will bring for us in the church this year, as we begin meeting to explore revitalising the parishes. How will God equip us with the right information and resources in our journey ahead. Are there any small changes we can give thanks for, or alterations we feel we could be part of making to plan and resource us in preparation?

While of course we don't like the wet weather too much it can also be a blessing that the land is refreshed and renewed in springtime. Maybe we can pray too for refreshment and renewal in our spiritual lives that equips us to continue praising God for all we have around us on our wonderful planet.


