

Thank you to everyone who has been involved in the busy period at Christmas. Whether that's through inviting friends and families to attend or supporting the services through teaching and intercessions or helping wash up afterwards, all of us have vital role to play in the life of the church.

Sometimes we are able to help financially too, and our regular givers support the ministry we are able to provide. Running a parish with three churches includes supporting lay people who help with services, as well as providing services for the congregations themselves. As a priest I also have a wider community role with the local primary schools and care homes, and in arranging burials in our graveyard. It also involves welcoming couples for weddings and families for baptisms.

The church also supported the Remembrance Day events with the Hunsley Churches together, in November. Sadly there was disagreement on how this should be organised, and this led to a separate event organised by the RAF Cadets taking place. In 2025 we are praying we can resolve this and one Civic event can happen which can reflect the desire for peace and unity in remembrance of the Armistice, for those of all faiths and none.

Without your support this work would not be possible and I pray that in 2025 we can continue to grow in showing the generosity of God through our time, energy, finance, prayer life and outreach with others.

Joint PCC

From January 2025 the Church has a new structure. While Brantingham, and Elloughton-cum Brough remain two parishes, the organisation for our church life together has become joint under one PCC or Parochial Church Council. This will mean after Easter that we have one bank account for all three churches for our day to day life, and one committee to decide how we achieve our goals in 'Living Christ's Story'. The different church buildings will all still have their own committees for things like the day to day planning of services, fundraising and maintenance. These will be called Management Committees. 2025 Fundraising

The social committee in 2024 raised an incredible amount for the parish of Elloughton cum Brough. This is in addition to the coffee morning team who have also fundraised a great deal for church in 2024 (£747.60) and £1319.72 for other charities including Martin House Hospice, Barnabas Aid, Hull YFC and MacMillan Cancer

Through grant applications we also raised £6865 towards the vestry roof and £6890 for the new toilet at All Saints Brough. One off donations for the vestry roof at St Mary's from our parish also totalled £7,000.


