#### **Happy Birthday Tiny Footsteps!**

**The group** celebrated its 15th birthday on Friday 7 th February. One of our parents made us a beautiful birthday cake which we all shared, we sang Happy Birthday and played pass the parcel. The children came dressed in their party clothes and we all had a lovely time. Set up in 2009, the Church playgroup succeeded Little Fishes which closed down in 2008 when the Vicar at the time and his wife moved on. Over the past 15 years, the group has offered support for post natal depression, adoption, fostering, drug addiction, general children's ailments and sometimes just a friendly face to talk to.

The group meets on a Friday morning in term time in Saint Mary's Hall from 10am –11.45am. We currently have children ranging from 6 weeks to 4½ years old who attend with their parent(s), grandparent(s), carer(s), childminder etc. Each week has a bible theme and this term is the parables of Jesus. A craft is provided along with toys, jigsaws, painting etc. We also have a baby area. The children enjoy juice and biscuits towards the end of the session before we finish with song time – a mixture of nursery rhymes and religious songs. The children's favourite is always The Wise Man Built His House Upon the Rock where the rainmakers are shaken vigorously and actions enjoyed. If you have a child or look after a child aged 0-5, why not come along and join us – coffee and cake provided.

#### Bereavement and Friendship Café

The first session went well using some of the Church of England's resources to support people in discussing grief. We are planning to meet monthly on the last Wednesday of the month from 1-3pm at St Mary's Hall for refreshments and home-baked scones. The next date is March 26th. Please do invite anyone you know who might enjoy a chat and some company to talk about loved ones or other forms of grief. Hilary, Jean and Sandra will be leading this from St Mary's.

#### **Electoral Roll**

The Electoral Roll of the Parish is the list of people entitled to vote at the annual meeting, and a measure of the churches membership. In 2025 the electoral roll is to be completely revised. Everyone who wishes to be on the electoral roll you will need to complete a new application form which will be available in church.

#### **Restoration works at Brantingham:**

The works at Brantingham have been going on for a few months now and we hope to be reopening church very soon. Until we can give a definitive date we thought we would share some background information on the project.

Fundraising was a fantastic achievement in 2024 with a range of approaches taking place, from our wall safe in church for an open afternoon, special gifts given by individuals, and donations online through a special appeal. We have also had a successful grant application of £3,000 and our Harvest supper raised £1,151.35. In total this has given us an additional £7,503.05 towards the works. Brantingham Church has also been successfully fundraising towards the repairs for several years. The works involve substantial investment due to the skilled work of the stonemasons in replacing stones which have become loose or worn and the removal, restoration and reinstatement of our stained glass windows. In addition we have begun using a 'Collectin' which allows digital giving to happen in our regular church services. In six months, this has raised an additional £371 towards our everyday running costs and maintenance of the church. Brantingham also supports other churches, including a Christian charity called Embrace who work with communities in the middle east to support local people and another cause more close to home on Bramsholme Estate through the Bodmin Moor Church. This totalled £1400 in 2024.
