As we come into the end of the calendar year, it is also a new year for many children at school and hopefully for us too in our discipleship and learning about Jesus. It's time to take stock and hopefully to notice how things have been going in 2024 so far. The harvest of our work is sometimes hard to notice but the areas that I have found encouraging so far, are in the enthusiasm and support I see in all three church congregations, and our willingness to give things a try. So many people contribute to the busy life of all three churches, so it is hard to say thank you to everyone, but without all of us working as a team, the church simply would not exist .

It's been a busy year with many weddings, baptisms and funerals as well as our regular worship. At the same time we've been trying to notice who we are as a community, and how God wants to see us grow and gain new energy and strength in the years ahead.

I am not sure if you have experienced this yourself but often I have found God seeks to help us grow through our own struggles and difficulties and it is no different as a community, when we tackle the areas we are concerned about, we can often see fresh starts and new growth happening. We plan to become a Joint PCC in January to help us focus on the next phase of life together, as Christians working in unity towards a common goal, and to breathe new life into the infrastructure or 'scaffolding' that supports our lives together. I believe this will bring us to an even more fruitful way of working in 2025.

So my prayer for us this Autumn is that we will carefully begin the process of putting away any areas of our lives together as a church that hold us back, and make space so that we can prepare the ground for new things that are taking shape and are planned for Spring. My prayer is that we will gain strength to do this through understanding and having confidence in our identity as a community, shaped by Jesus Christ, and his life and sacrifice. I pray this will inspire us to trust God, and to give thanks for all we have been given this harvest time.
