Come and join us on the evening of 12<sup>th</sup> September for a two part talk; the History of the Port and Mike's time there.

Mike's career in the port industry spanned from 1970 until his retirement in 2003. During this time he was employed by the British Transport Docks Board and after privatization, by Associated British Ports (ABP).

He was employed as a Stevedoring Operations Manager at Hull from 1977-1979 and as Port Director from 1987 until his retirement in 2003, which included the abolition of the Dock Labour Scheme, the end of crippling labour disputes, the opening of Alexandra dock and the growth of the port.

Mike also undertook a spell at ABP's Headquarters in London and at various times was also responsible for the ports of Ipswich, King's Lynn and Goole.
